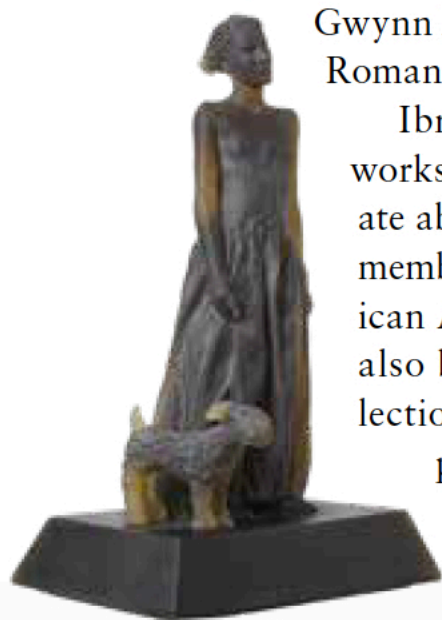


Sculptural Whimsey

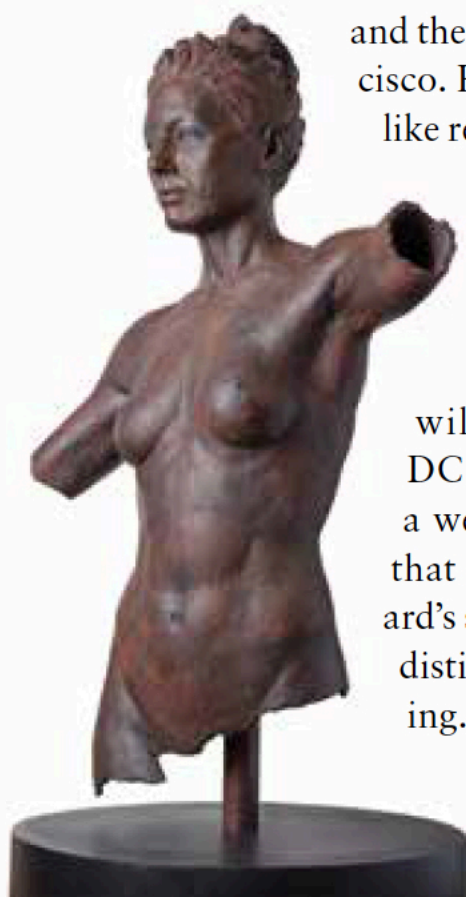


Ibran Lassaw Arana is an artist who works directly with braised bronze to create abstract sculpture. He was a founding member and former president of the American Abstract Artist group. His work can also be found in numerous museum collections. *1969 Bronze*, in the exhibition, presents a series of abstracted bronze planes and frames reminiscent of Abstract Expressionist painting, rendered in sculpture. Africano's recent work has centered around his wife and muse and gives us a look into her life. His work can be found in the collections of the Museum of Contemporary Art Chicago, The Milwaukee Museum of Art, The Whitney Museum of Art,

and the De Young Museum in San Francisco. His cast glass sculpture and life-like rendering in the exhibition is entitled *Girl with Dog*.



Sabin Howard is contemporary figurative sculptor; his most current project is a World War I memorial that will be installed in Washington DC. *Aphrodite Fragment* presents a well-known figure in art history, that of Venus and Aphrodite, Howard's sculpture however, features more distinct facial features in this rendering. “Sculpture Selections” continues to express various processes, methodologies, and styles of sculpture-making in the contemporary world.
